| <p>This IPP will explore social support, and models of cooperation between the state and non-profit world. Whilst working in a community kitchen, participants will work with volunteers to prepare daily meals, carry out maintenance work and restore public art. This will provide the background to a discussion about failing societal and economic support structures for marginalised members of society. Participants will be asked to consider can we change this model? How can we contribute to restoration of dignity? Is this a drop in the sea, or can small things change the life of others?</p> <p>Cucine Popolari (The People's Kitchen) is a canteen, or better a table, open to everybody in need, run by volunteers and funded by donations. Guests at the kitchen are invited to take a seat to eat and chat with the people sitting at your table: homeless, migrants, people in charge of the Social Services, lonely or elderly people...everybody is accepted.</p> <p>The partner will offer guest speakers to illustrate the model of cooperation between state/municipality social/community services and the various volunteer associations working in Italy. In return, the participants will illustrate the world of the disadvantaged in their own country and provide best practices for integration and social care.</p> | | |
